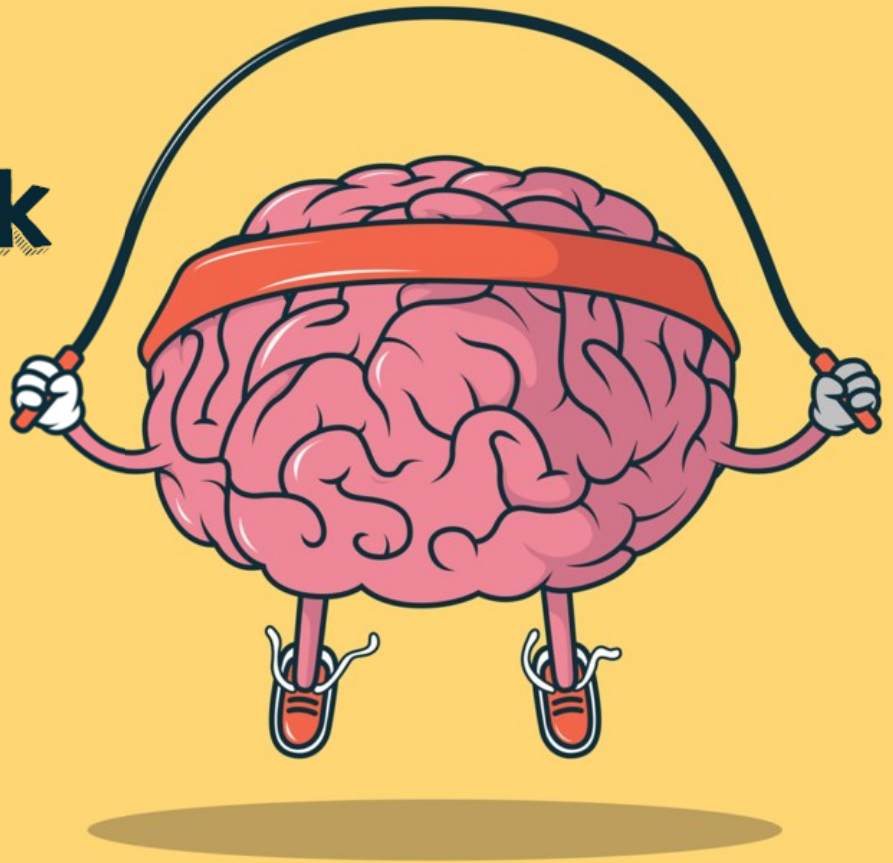

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will be putting on their Green Thinking Hats and continue creating our very own acrostic poems about Winter. The children will be continue exploring how to create poems that excite the reader and will be working with their friends to evaluate each other's work. At home, encourage your child to create an acrostic poem on a theme of their choice.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will develop their problem solving and reasoning skills through a selection of worded addition problems. They will be looking in their 'thinking toolbox' to select the resources they would like to use and will use their metacognitive skills to plan, monitor and evaluate their ability in solving the addition problems. At home, you can give your child simple worded problems to solve. In our Maths Project lesson, the children will be adding different coins together to make new amounts. At home, you can set up an imaginary shop and use real coins to purchase items. Children are also challenged to use real coins to buy things outside and to send in photos of them doing so.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue to explore gravity. The children will conduct an experiment to explore how magnets can alter the natural gravitational force. The children will be able to make a prediction about what will happen when you hold 3 paper clips from 3 pieces of string. We will then consider the results of our experiment, explaining our reasoning. At home, why not encourage your child to conduct further research into gravity.
