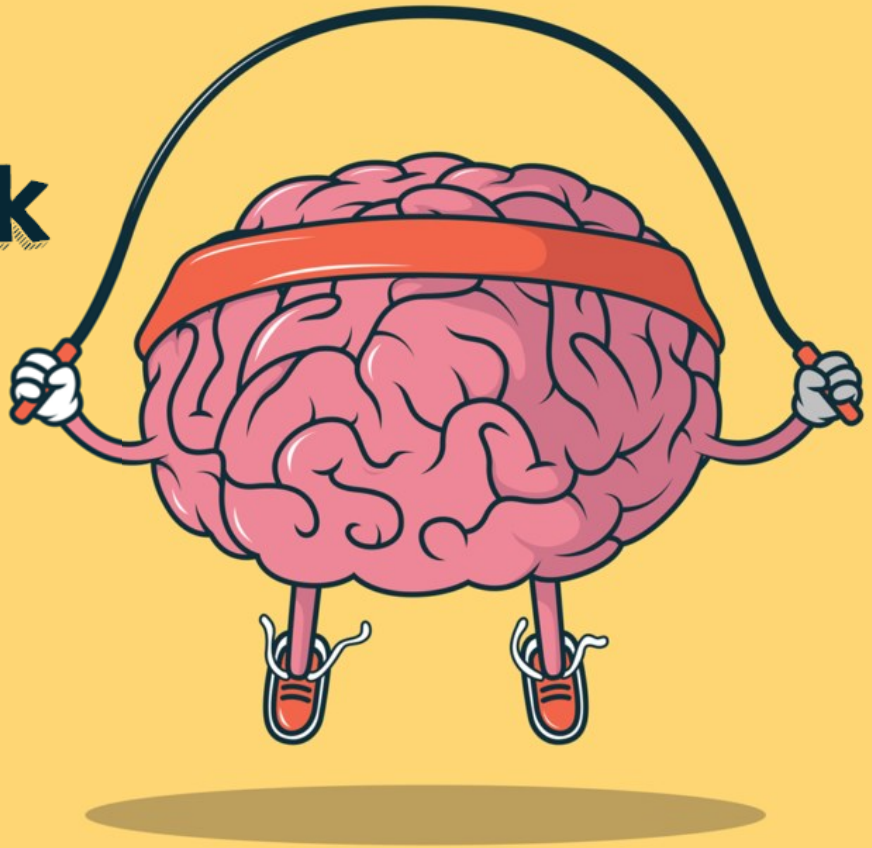

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will continue looking at using adjectives to describe a selection of Winter scenes. They will also be writing their own wish list for Christmas using their knowledge of Phonics to support them with their spelling. At home, you can practise writing simple sentences in the form of Christmas cards and Christmas wish lists.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will be wearing their white thinking hats to recap what they have been looking at throughout the term. They will be looking coin problems and will be using the tools from their Big Thinking Toolbox to support them. At home, you can continue utilising the online resources that will further strengthen their skills in solving Maths problems.

Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will understand sustainable ways to travel by looking at the effects of carbon footprint. The children will explain the advantages and disadvantages of burning fossil fuels. At home, encourage your child to complete a fact file of the effects of carbon footprint.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will understand that we had our first Prime Minister during Victorian era. We will also explore the introduction of Peel's Police Force.
