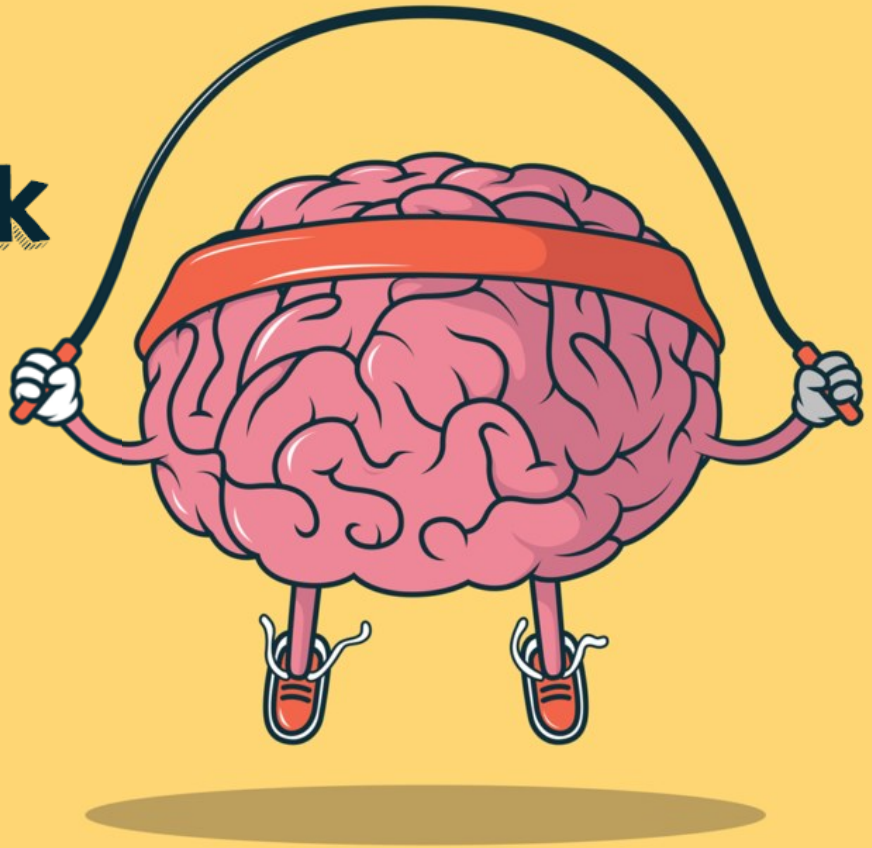

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

This week in Creative Writing, the children will continue exploring nonsense words and will read the story, 'The Sneetches' by Dr Seuss. The children will start to look at alliteration and are encouraged to search for examples of alliteration in the books they read at home. In Phonics, the children will look at the 'ai' sound and will create a defining thinking frame to list as many words as they can that contain this sound. At home, you can create a categorising thinking frame with a selection of sounds and different words your child can think of.

Maths

This week in our Maths Project lesson, the children will continue to explore coins and will be able to sort and use money in every day situations. They will be able to calculate the amount of change required in different situations. At home, encourage your child to take the role of a shopkeeper and/or a customer and familiarise themselves with real coins.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their study of 'the Earth'. They will examine the different continents that make up our world and labelling them correctly. At home, why not encourage your child to follow on from this and look at the countries that are close to us.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue to look at our Transport project. The children will look at record how we travel to school as a class using a pictogram, showing different modes of transport (e.g. walking, biking, car or bus). At home, encourage your child to talk about how different transport choices affect the environment, especially how cars and buses can cause air pollution.
