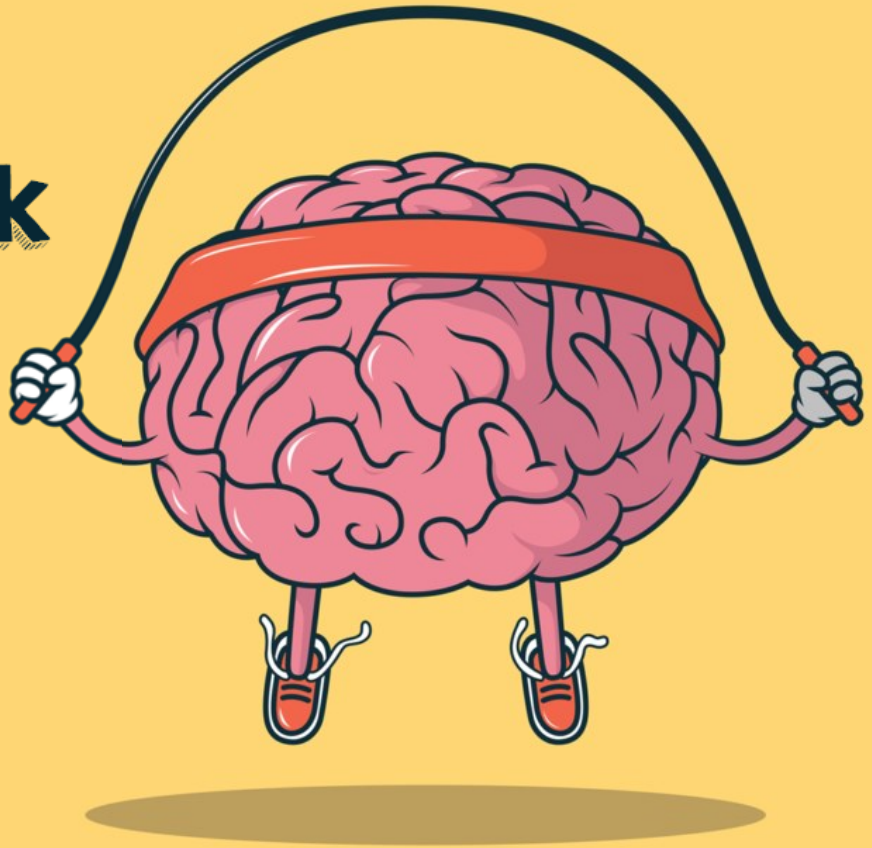

### Literacy

This week, in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will explore the story, 'Commotion in the Ocean' written by Giles Andreae. The children will wear their green thinking hats to create their own nonsense words and will continue to create their own rhyming sentences. At home, you can write a selection of rhyming words, cut them out and ask your child to match them.

### Maths

This week in our Maths Project lesson, the children will look at differences between 2D and 3D shapes. The children will look at recognising and recalling our 2D shapes and learn about 3D shapes. At home, try to look for all the shapes you can around your room.

### Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will have the opportunity to discuss how different climates and terrains vary and what grows there? The children will be able to conduct an experiment to see which are the best types of environment for growing things. At home, you can ask your child to explore the different ground they can find digging in the garden.

### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will learn what animals were used as transport, we will look at how animals carry things to help people to travel. We will look at the right way to treat animals and make sure they are happy and healthy when they are used for transport. At home, you can draw an image of an animal used as transport.
