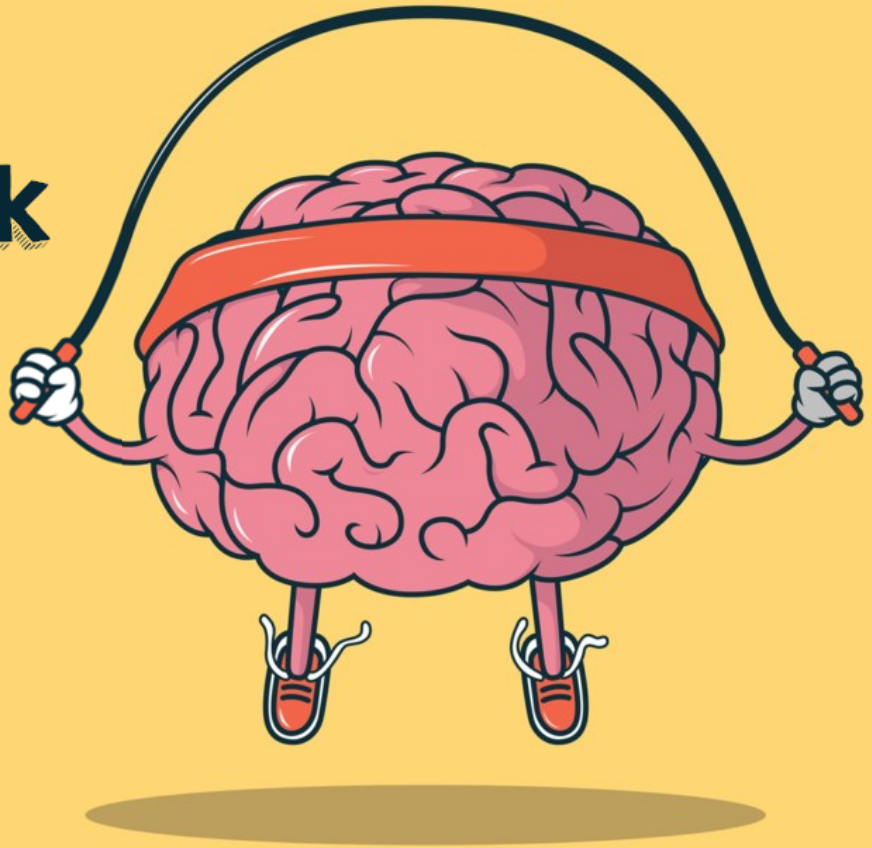

### Literacy

This week, in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will continue exploring the story, 'Commotion in the Ocean' written by Giles Andreae. The children will wear their green thinking hats again to continue creating their own nonsense words and will continue creating their own rhyming sentences as well. At home, encourage your child to think on a few nonsense words.

### Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will refine their understanding of 'one more' and 'one less' with numbers up to 50. At home, write a number on a piece of paper and ask your child to write 'one more' and 'one less' of that given number. In Maths Project, the children will begin learning about measurement and will be looking at measuring length. At home, you can use a ruler to measure the length of different objects.

### Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their new project about the World! We will explore our oceans. We will recognise and name the five oceans of the world. Then, we will accurately identify the position of each ocean on a globe. Finally, we will label a blank map with the names of the oceans in their proper locations. At home, why not encourage your child to research the Mariana Trench and all the fascinating animals that live there.

### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about modes of Transportation. This week we will focus on wheeled transport. The children will learn how identify the uses of some types of wheeled transport. At home, encourage your child to discuss the advantages and/or disadvantages of wheeled transport.
