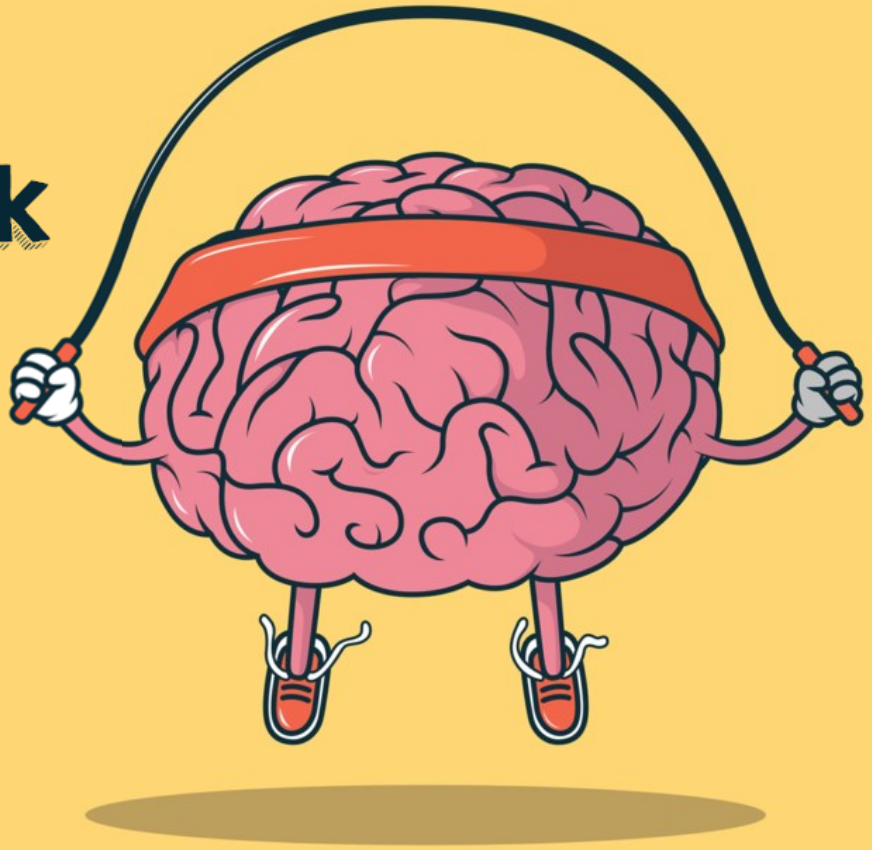

Literacy

This week, in our Literacy lessons, the children will look at 'Hairy Maclary from Donaldson's Dairy' by Lindley Dodd. Using the Green Thinking Hat, we will engage the children in brainstorming activities to generate a wide range of adjectives that describe the characters in this book. We will also use a wide range of adjectives to create 'wanted' posters. At home, you can encourage your child to describe things that are important to them, such as their bedroom or a special toy, using a wide range of adjectives.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will consolidate their knowledge of one more and one less with numbers up to 50. The children will be able to use a number line to work out one more and one less of numbers to 50. The children will also start to think of the concept of one more and one less with numbers up to 100 by the end of the lesson. At home, encourage your children to use Lego pieces to help them understand the total amount of a given quantity when taking one or two away.

Science

In Science this week, the children will learn about volcanoes. We will start discussing what a volcano is and children will have the opportunity to share their experiences if they have seen a real one. Then, we will identify volcano features and volcanic processes. At home, why not try researching volcanoes in Europe.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about modes of Transportation. We will focus on marine transport and how they have evolved over time. The children will have the opportunity to look at how marine transport moves (eg. sails, engines). At home, encourage your child to discuss the differences between wheeled transport and marine transport.
