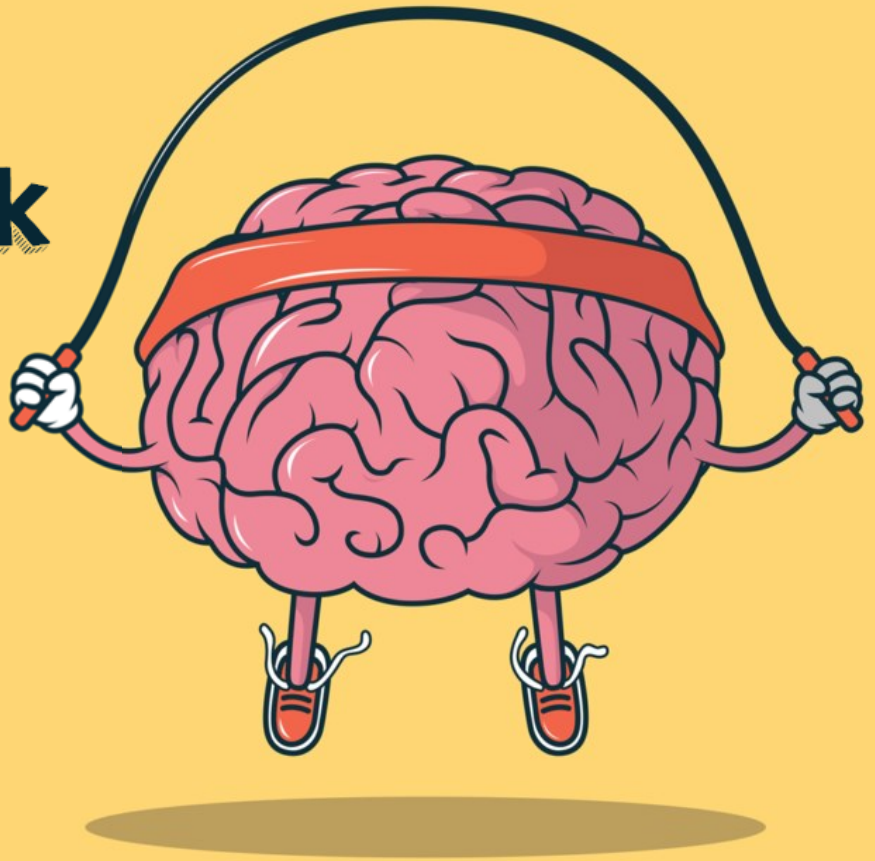

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will engage their five senses and will write about a given scene, describing what they can see, hear, taste, smell and touch. At home, ask your child to wear their White Thinking Hats to describe what they see can, hear and smell in their favourite place outdoors and then write a short passage to share with their friends in class. In Phonics, the children will be looking at the the 'ou' sound and will be encouraged to complete a few activities with that sound.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will recall, recognise, and create basic patterns verbally and through writing by counting by twos. The children will be able to complete sequences by counting in 2s. Children will practise using the 100 square and highlight the numbers while counting in 2's. We will encourage the children to physically skip one bead and land on the next one. At home, encourage your child to use counters and a number line to visualise jumping in 2s.

Science

In Science this week, the children will explore climate change and its effects on our planet. They will define some of the causes and effects of climate change and then offer possible practical solutions to climate change. At home, why not encourage your child to create a poster with their solutions to our climate.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about modes of Transportation. We will focus on at least three important road safety rules and explain why these rules are important for staying safe. The children will look at plotting a simple journey using key landmarks. At home, encourage your child to design a detailed journey map with road safety reminders.
