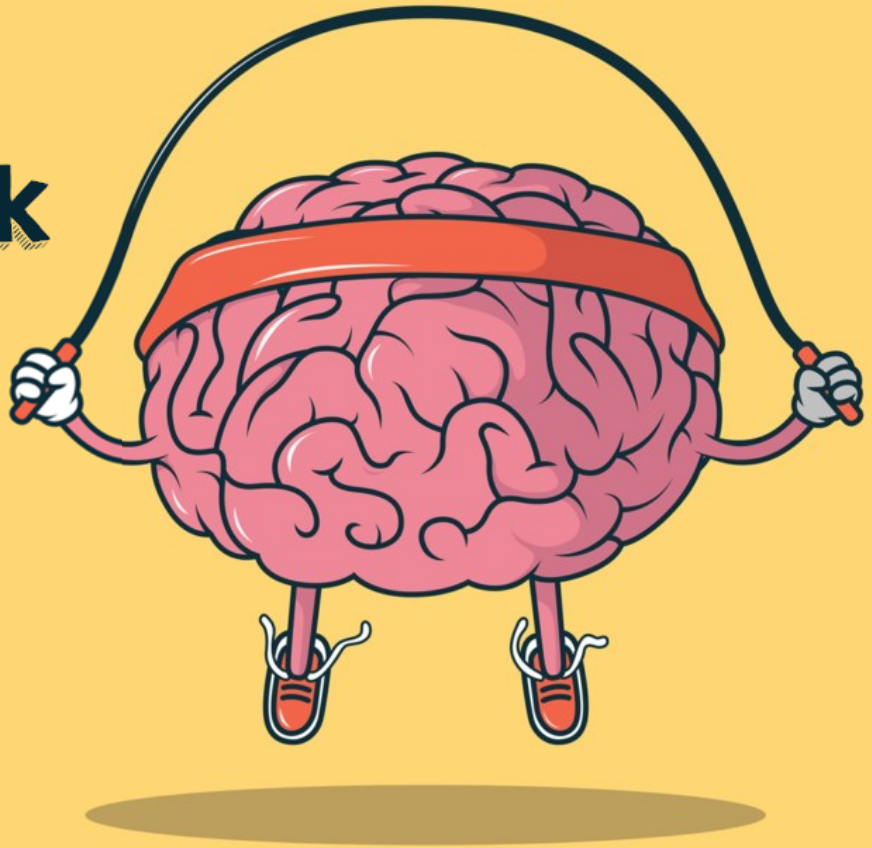

Literacy

This week, in our Literacy lessons, the children will continue looking at 'Hairy Maclary from Donaldson's Dairy' by Lindley Dodd. Using the Green Thinking Hat, we will continue looking at activities to generate a wide range of adjectives that describe the characters in this book. At home, you can encourage your child to describe their favourite character so far.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will work on recalling number bonds to ten using concrete objects to support their learning. The children will look at how two different numbers can make the number 10. At home, encourage your children to make a tower of 10 using Lego pieces and ask them to find all the different combinations in two colours to make 10.

Science

In Science this week, the children will investigate how icebergs are formed. The children will create an iceberg using a balloon and some water. Then, filling a container with salty water will explore how only a tiny portion of the iceberg stays above the surface of the water. At home, why not encourage your child to explore ice and how we could create ice cubes.

Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about modes of Transportation. We will focus on types of flying machines and their uses. We will look at how flying machines stay in the air (eg. Wings, propellers). The children will look at how flying machines have evolved over time. At home, encourage your child to draw their favourite flying machine.
