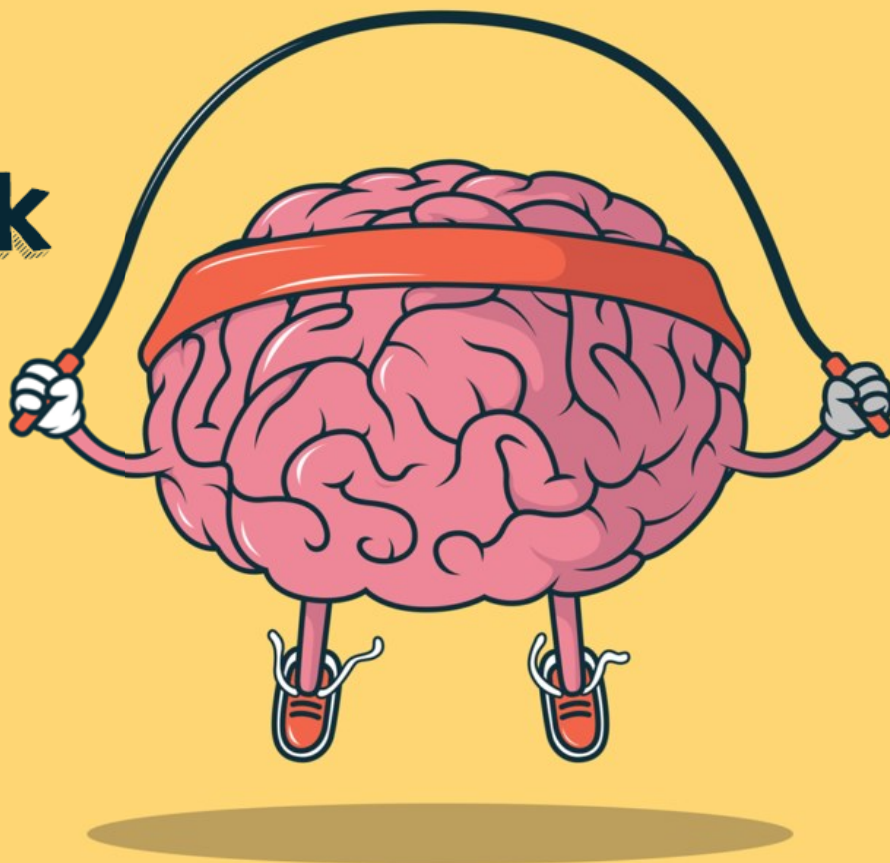

### Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will go on an exciting safari and will wear their Green Thinking Hats to create both verbal and written reports based on their experiences. At home, you can ask your child to write a report about one of their favourite activities. In Phonics, we will be looking at the 'or' sound and encourage children to write down as many words as they can think of that contain this sound.

### Maths

This week in our Maths lessons, the children will continue to practise numbers up to 20. How two numbers could make the number 20. We will also consolidate their knowledge of number bonds. We will ensure the children are able to recall numbers up to 30. In Maths Project, the children will continue using rulers to measure the length and height of different objects. At home, please encourage your child to measure different objects and to write down their findings.

### Science

This week in our Science lesson, the children will understand that climate change is the pattern of weather over many, many years. We will continue investigating basic concepts about climate change. The children will be able to recognise the dangers of climate change from an environmental perspective. At home, encourage your child to do a research on climate change, causes, effects and possible solutions.

### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will look at how trains move. Explaining that different trains are powered by different things. The children will also have the opportunity to compare different types of trains. At home, encourage your child to reflect and research how trains evolved over time.
