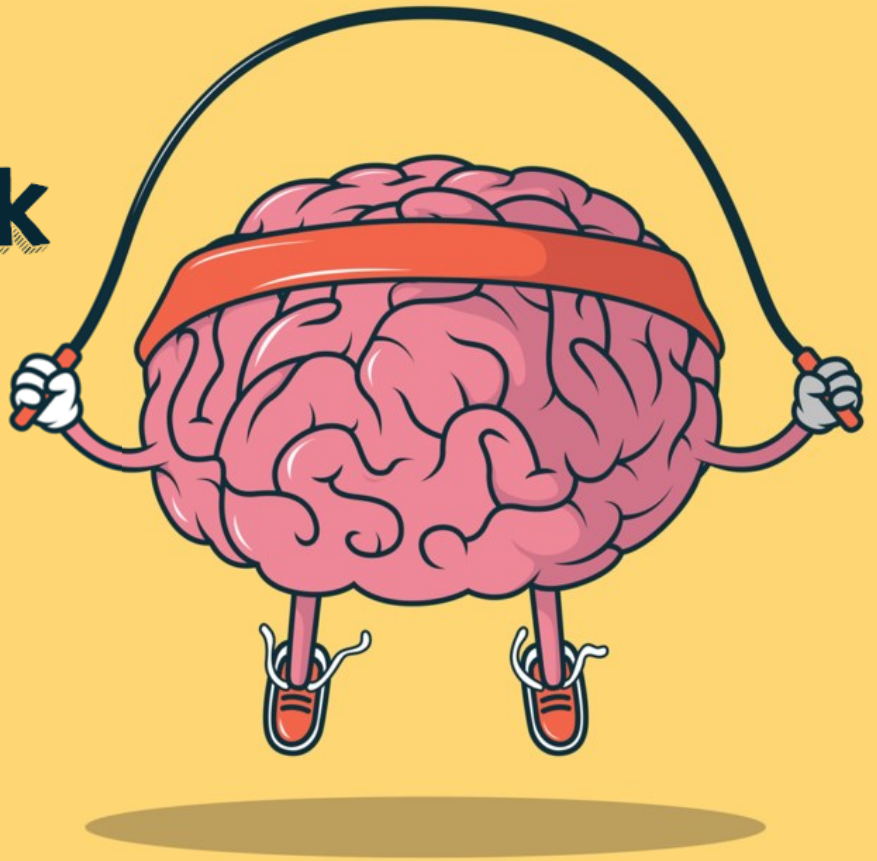

# This week we are learning to...



## Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will continue engaging in and investigating their five senses, and continue writing about a scene, describing what they can see, hear, taste, smell and touch. At home, ask your child to wear their White Thinking Hats to describe what they see can, hear and smell in their bedroom.

## Maths

In Maths this week, the children will continue to recall, recognise, and create basic patterns verbally and through writing by counting by twos. The children will be able to complete sequences by counting in 10s. Children will practise using the 100 square and highlight the numbers while counting in 10's. We will encourage the children to physically skip one bead and land on the next one. At home, encourage your child to count in 10's up to 50, then gradually up to 100.

## Science

In Science this week, the children will explore sustainability and the importance of looking after our planet. Splitting into small groups, the children will conduct an experiment of combining oil and water. This experiment will be an opportunity for our pupils to reflect on how oil spills can affect seabirds. At home, why not encourage your child to conduct further research into sustainability.

## Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will continue learning about modes of Transportation. We will focus on understand the long distances our food travels to reach us. We will look at the environmental impact of transporting goods, using vocabulary like "carbon footprint" or "sustainable". At home, encourage your child to plot the journey of a specific item using a map.
