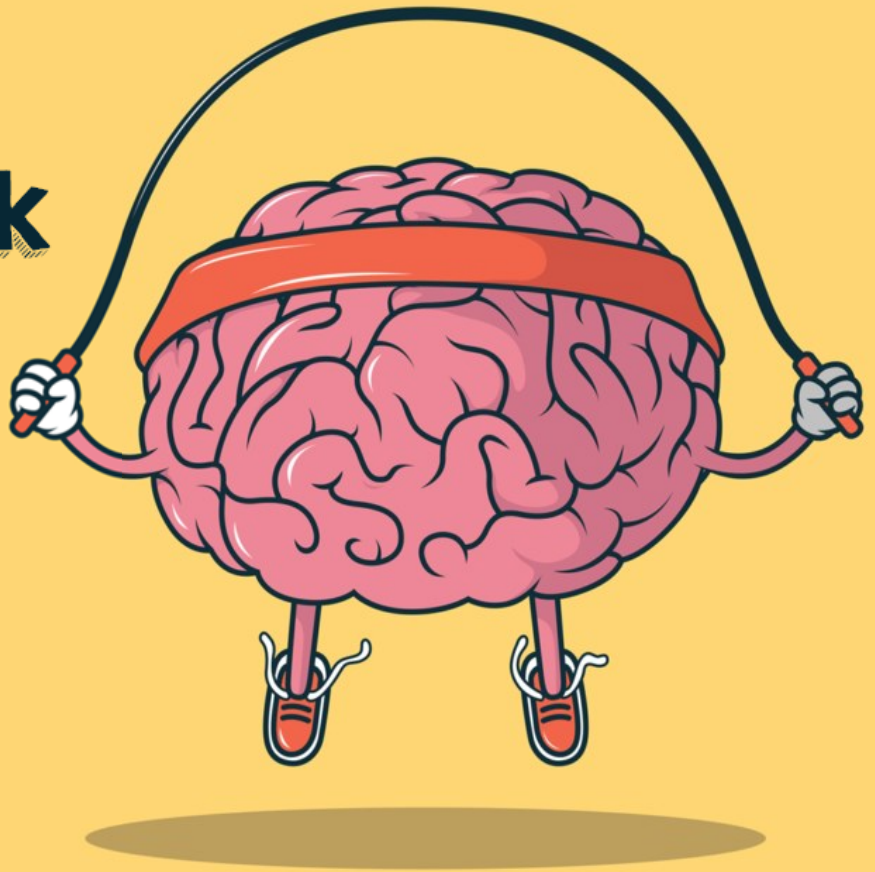

### Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will review our investigation of their five senses, and we will recap what they thought about it. We will access what we see, hear, taste, smell and touch. At home, ask your child to wear their White Thinking Hats to describe their favourite sense and why.

### Maths

In Maths this week, the children will learn about doubling and halving numbers. The children will be able to use concrete objects to help them discover double and half of a given number up to 10. At home, encourage your child to use concrete objects to support your child with halving and doubling numbers up to 30.

### Science

In Science this week, the children will understand that most of the energy comes from burning of fossil fuels such as coal, oil and natural gas. They will look at an alternative energy called renewable energy, meaning a source that does not finish. At home, your child could look at images of different energy sources and discuss where does the energy come from and why do we need energy?

### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will look at sustainability in relation to travel, they will identify one or two negative impacts of transport on the environment. We will explain to the class how different types of transport affect the environment. At home your child could design a unique sustainable mode of transport, considering the materials, energy source and environment impact.
