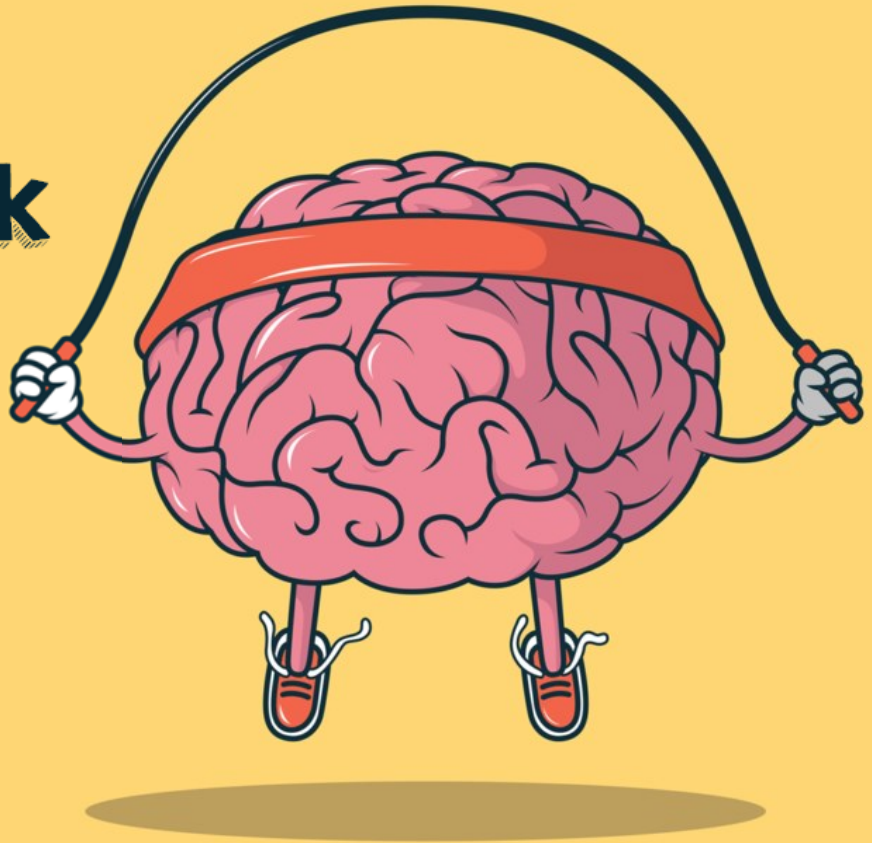

#### Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will think of different adjectives to describe the recent Spring fete and will work as a group to create a describing thinking frame. They will then become reporters for their very own newspaper and will write a report about the Spring fete remembering to use adjectives, verbs and time connectives. At home, you can encourage your child to create a journal that they can complete using adjectives.

#### Maths

In Maths this week, the children will learn about halving shapes and objects. The children will be able to recognise when shapes can be split into half. The children will be encourage to use specific vocabulary such as 'half' and 'whole'. At home, encourage your child to look at real life objects and how they can be cut in half. Which objects can be split into equal halves?

#### Science

In Science this week, the children will explore deforestation and the importance of looking after our planet. The children will explore the role of trees and plants in combating climate change. The children will research this and explain the affects of deforestation on our planet. They will be able to explain what deforestation is, listing the issues which occur as a result of deforestation. At home, why not encourage your child to create two images one showing a healthy planet and another one showing signs of deforestation.

#### Project

This week in our Project lesson, the children will look at identify at least one unique mode of transport and the country it comes from. We will explain the basic features and purpose. At home, your child could design and create their unique mode of transport.
