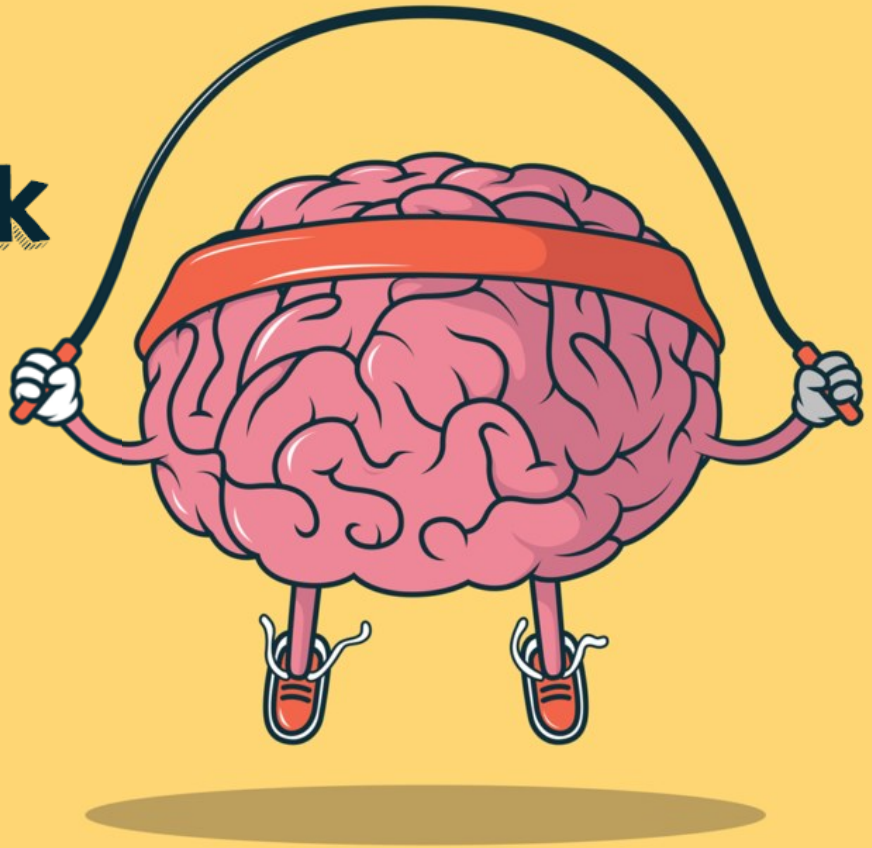

Literacy

This week in our Creative Writing lesson, the children will work on how to decorate Easter eggs. The children will use bossy verbs and adjectives to describe in detail their creations. The children will work on writing a set of instructions to explain how we should decorate our Easter Eggs ready for our Holidays. At home, you can encourage your child to create their own designs and maybe even do a Easter Hunt.

Maths

This week in our Maths Number lesson, the children will engage in Maths consolidation activities and will review concepts covered over the term. The children will be using their metacognitive skills and the Meditative Macaque to reflect on their own learning and will think about which areas they would like to work during their break. At home, you can continue to use concrete objects to practise halving and doubling numbers as well as giving your child worded addition and subtraction problems.

Science

In Science this week, the children will explore the Greenhouse Effect. The children will identify what gases contribute to the greenhouse effect. They will make simple links between increased greenhouse gases in the atmosphere and global warming. They will then discuss the consequences of global warming. Through a fun experiment we will explore the Greenhouse Effect. This weekend, why not take a trip to the Science Museum and explore more about the Greenhouse Effect there?

Project

This week, in our Project lesson, the children will be learning more about a new transport invention. The children will have the opportunity to do a research about it and explain why it is useful and how their invention improves travel for future generations. At home, encourage your child to reflect on the modes of transport looked so far and they have studied and choose the materials they think would be most appropriate to use to build one.
