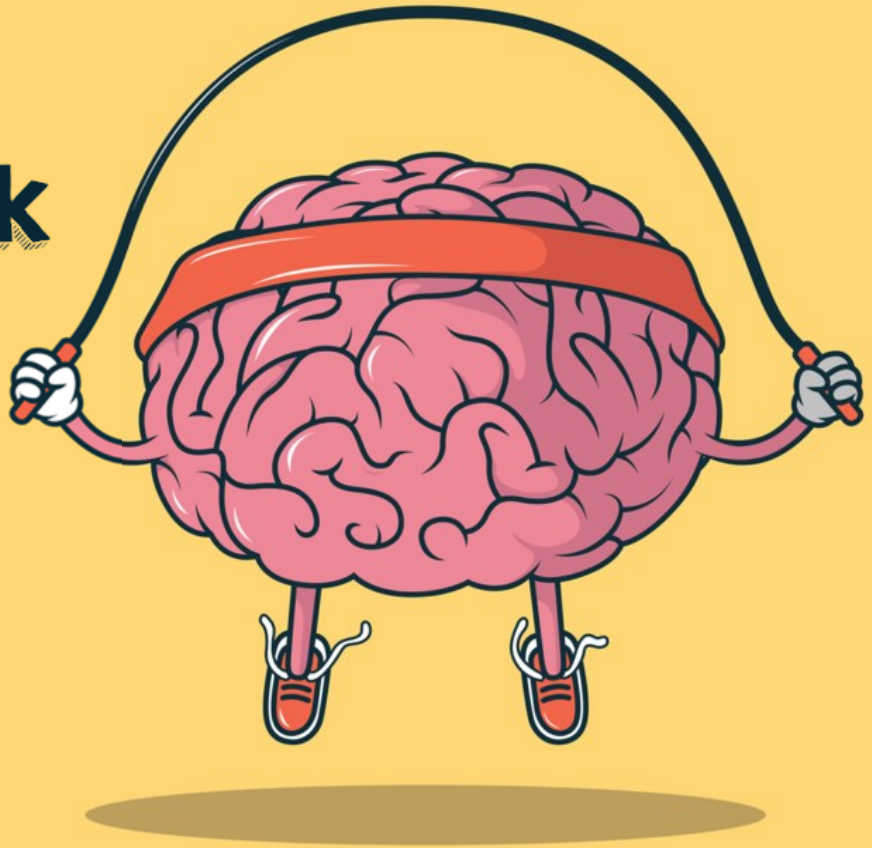

### Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be recognising the number 2. At home, you could ask the children to find these numbers in different rooms. You could also go for a walk and see how many of these numbers you can see. Your child can also use some chalk to make their own representation of the numbers.

### Literacy

This week, the children will be drawing self-portraits using mark making tools. The children will be describing their features using key vocabulary such as: head, ears, nose, eyes and mouth. At home, you can support your child with practising their tripod grip. You can also encourage your child to point to different parts of their body, a great way to do this is through the rhyme "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes".

### Project

This week, we move on from our 'All about me' project to our 'People who help us' project. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about people who help us at home. At home, talk to your child about the people who live at home with them, and how they help them. You can also talk about who else your child meets/sees, and who helps them too. We will be discussing these people over the coming weeks.
