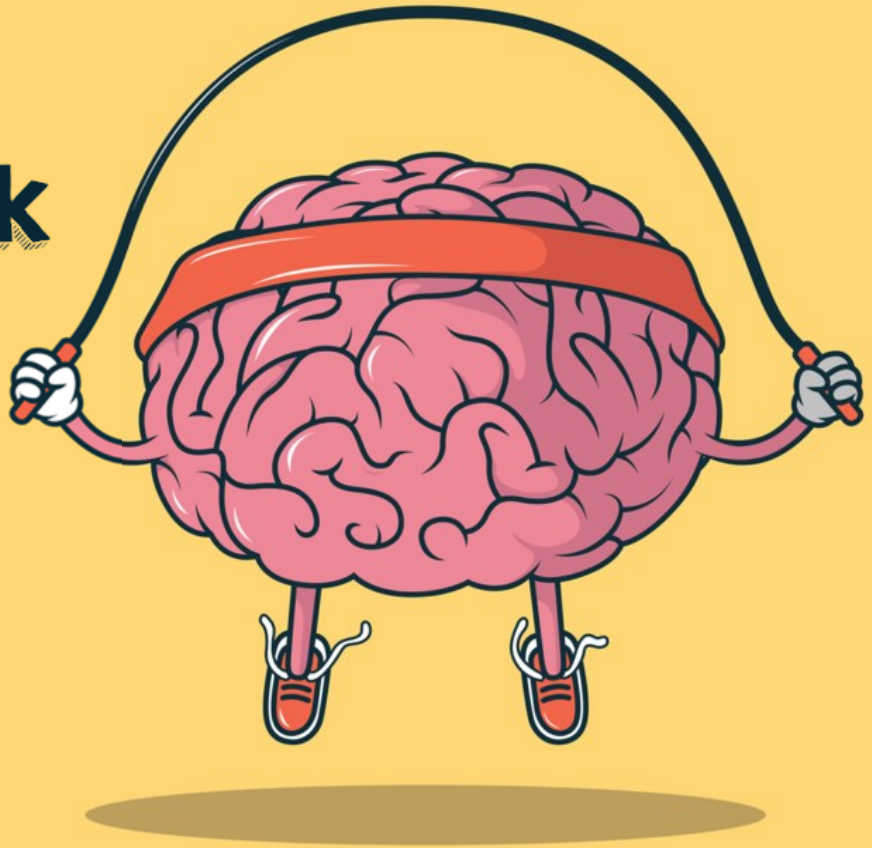

Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be recognising the number 2. At home, you could ask the children to find these numbers in different rooms. You could also go for a walk and see how many of these numbers you can see. Your child can also use some chalk to make their own representation of the numbers.

Literacy

This week, the children will be drawing self-portraits using mark making tools. The children will be describing their features using key vocabulary such as: head, ears, nose, eyes and mouth. At home, you can support your child with practising their tripod grip. You can also encourage your child to point to different parts of their body, a great way to do this is through the rhyme "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes".

Project

This week, the Squirrels' class will be exploring and expanding the children's taste buds with a cultural food day. Parents are asked to bring in a dish from home, for the children to taste. The children will be learning about their different taste senses. For example; sweet, savoury, salty, bitter and sour. At home, we can be great chefs! Encourage your child to help you make a fruit salad or even do some baking. The children love cooking and it is a great opportunity to improve their motor skills by cutting and mixing.
