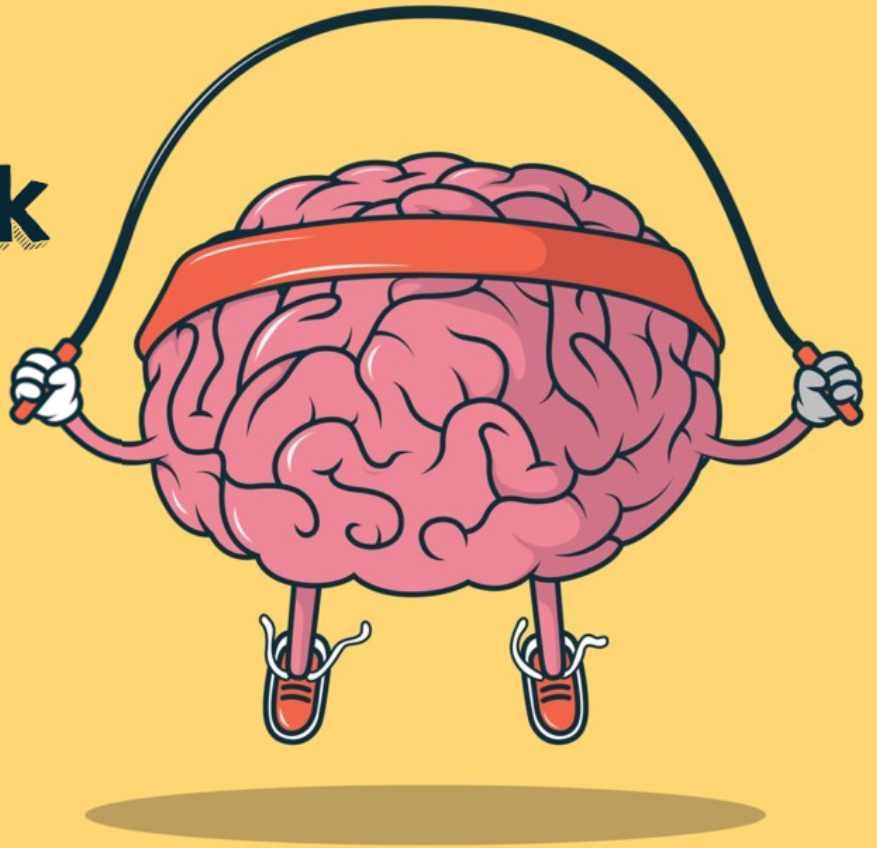

### Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be learning about triangles. Using 2D shapes and triangle toys as visual aid, the children will be recognising and sorting shapes into baskets, discovering triangles in the environment too. At home, you can have triangle shapes for your child to find, like a shape hunt. Your child can also count how many sides and corners the triangle has.

### Literacy

This week, the Squirrels' class will be finding different plants and flowers outside. They will then take part in observational drawings to draw what they see. At home, you can encourage your child to draw what they see in the garden or local park. You can support your child to do this by encouraging them to hold the writing material with their thumb and first two fingers. This is known as the 'Tripod grip'.

### Project

This week, in our 'People who help us' project, the children will be discussing and role playing their experiences with the firefighters. This week the Squirrels' class will be exploring what a firefighter does and how they help us. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about what they think a firefighter does. At home, ask your child what number to call if they spot a fire and what puts it out. You could use empty clean spray bottles to practise spraying water. This is a great idea to develop your child's fine motor skills.
