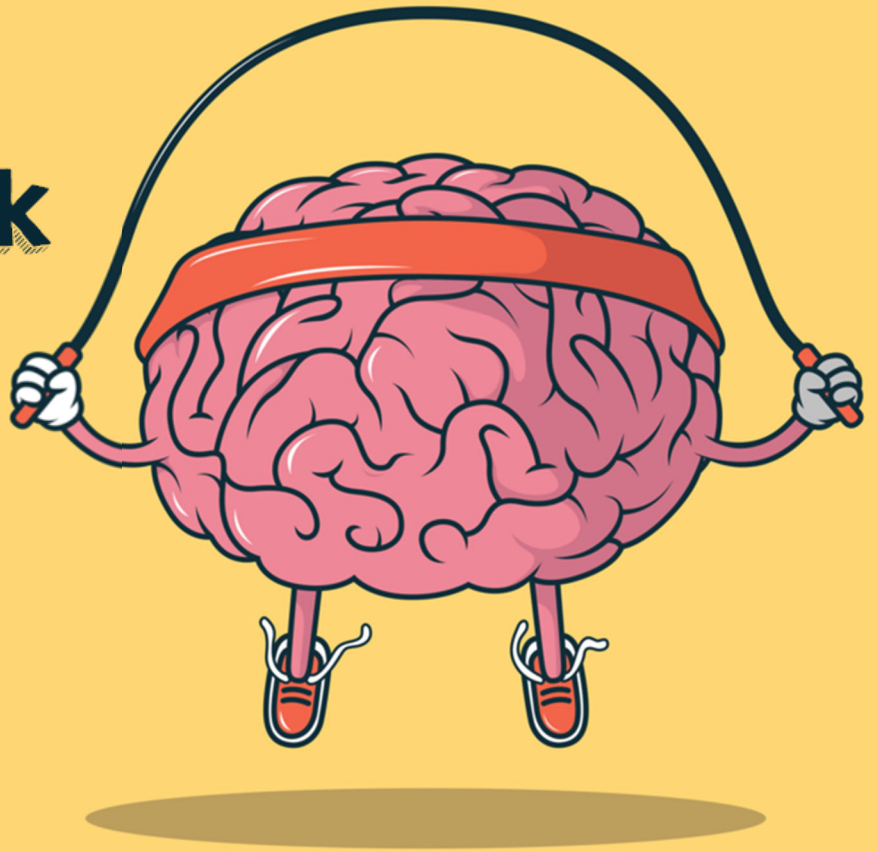

This week we are learning to...



Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be looking at different sized objects, focusing on the vocabulary big and small. At home, see if your child can put some shoes in order of size. Encourage the children to identify and compare the smallest shoe and the biggest shoe. A discussion on different sized objects around your home is a great way to extend and continue this learning objective.

Literacy

This week, the children will be exploring what the post office does. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about what the postal service do and create our own cards and letters. At home, you could send a card of kindness to a loved one or a neighbour. This is a great way to show how much we appreciate each other. You can support your child to do this by encouraging them to hold the writing material with their thumb and first two fingers. This is known as the 'Tripod grip'.

Project

This week in our 'People who help us' project, the children will be exploring what a doctor does and some of the equipment that they use to help up. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about what a doctor does and even if we have any past experience. At home, ask you child why they think we go to the doctors, and maybe create your own Teddies clinic for sick bears.
