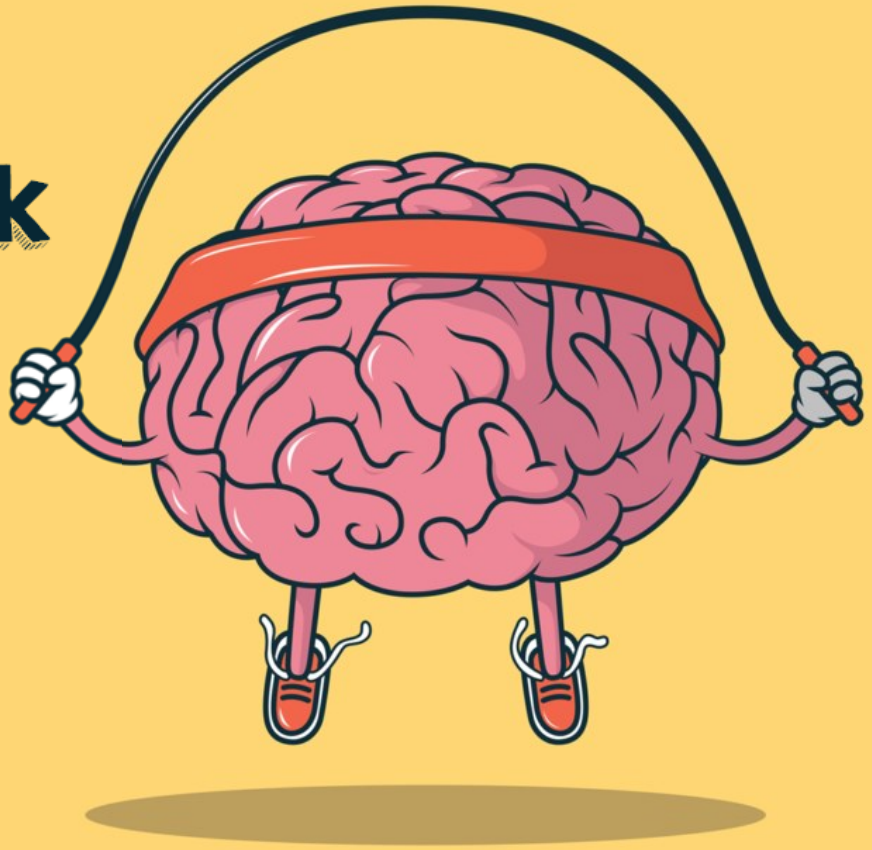

This week we are learning to...



Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be recapping their understanding of triangles. Using 2D shapes and triangular toys as a visual aid, the children will be recognising and sorting shapes into baskets, and also discovering triangular shapes in the environment. At home, why not go on a shape hunt and get your child to look for all of the triangles they can see? Your child can also count how many sides and corners a triangle has.

Literacy

This week, the Squirrels' class will be creatively using tools to make marks in shaving foam. At home, you can use the end of a paintbrush, spoons and fingers to make marks in a small tray or a small plate of shaving foam. You can also encourage your child at home to make straight lines or circles. Remember to support your child by encouraging them to hold the writing material with their thumb and first two fingers. This is known as the 'Tripod grip'.

Project

This week in our 'People who help us' project, we will be discussing and role playing the children's experiences of going on an aeroplane. The children will be exploring what aeroplanes and airports are, and how they help us. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about where the children would like to go on holiday. At home, discuss any previous experiences your child has had at an airport or of going on a plane. They could even pack a pretend suitcase with things they think they will need for their holiday. This is a great idea to develop the children's imaginative skills.
