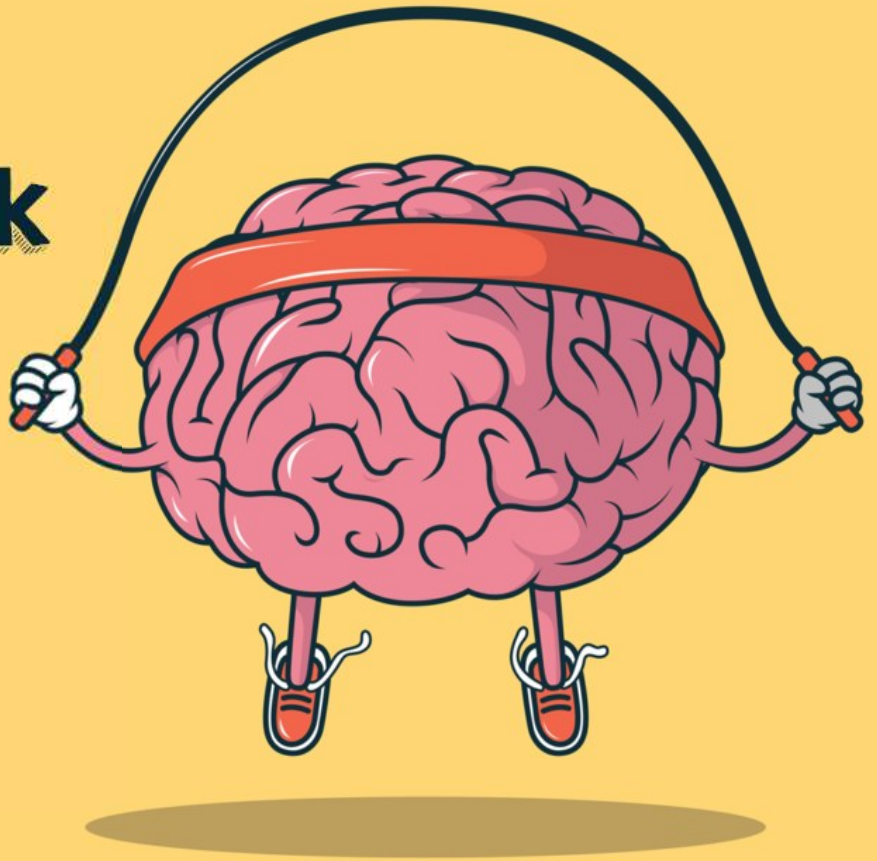

This week we are learning to...



Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, the children will practise using adverbs within their writing. The children will reflect on their weekend using adverbs to help describe the events. At home, you could encourage your child to identify adverbs as they are reading with you. Once they have identified these adverbs they can use them in their own writing.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be studying rounding numbers. We will identify the Golden Rule of Rounding which is that if the digit is five or more, we round up. For example: 36 would become 40. If the digit is less than 5, you round down. For example: 32 would become 30. We will apply this along with our knowledge of place value to rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We will approach rounding to the nearest whole number. At home, you could use walking talking maths opportunities to practise rounding as your child is doing their daily activities on the weekend.

Science

This week in Science, the children have started an exciting new topic: Forces and Magnetism! They'll be exploring how and why objects change shape when different forces are applied. At home, you could support their learning by encouraging them to gather everyday items from around the house or garden. Ask them to experiment with applying the following forces: squeeze, twist, and stretch — and observe what happens to each item's shape.
