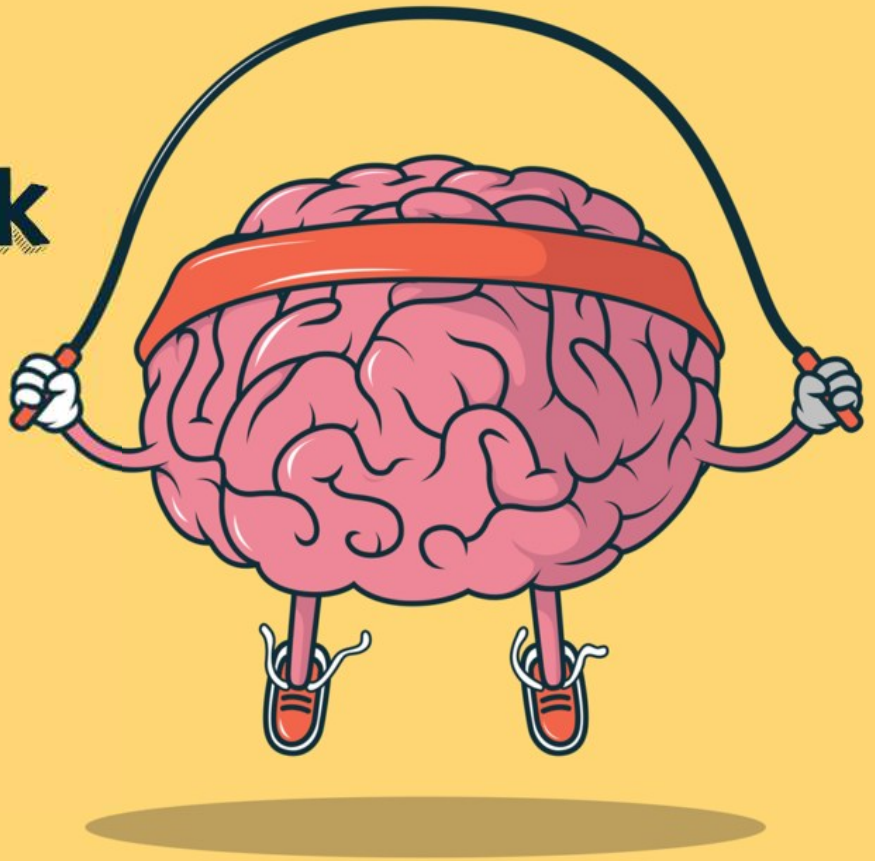

Literacy

In our Writing lessons this week, the children will practise separating their work into paragraphs. They will explore how and why we use paragraphs, understanding that they start a new paragraph when they start a new topic or focus. The children will reflect on the weekend and write a recount of the memorable events. At home, encourage your child to separate their work into paragraphs when they are writing.

Maths

In our Maths lessons this week, the children will be studying fractions. We will review fractions of a shape. Then, we will identify the numerator and denominator in fractions. The numerator is the number that sits at the top. It represents how many equal parts of the whole are present. The denominator is the number at the bottom. It tells us how many equal parts the whole is divided into. We will follow the steps to calculate a fraction of a number, first dividing and then multiplying. We will calculate a fraction of a quantity, working through the steps in the correct order e.g. $\frac{1}{5}$ of 20 equals 4 because 20 (quantity) divided by 5 (denominator) equals 4. At home, encourage your child to practise fractions when they are cooking with you.

Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their investigation of Forces. The children will investigate reflection and refraction, learning the differences between the two. They will identify real-life examples of each and label diagrams. At home, why not have your child try using a prism and a mirror to explain the family what reflection and refraction is.
