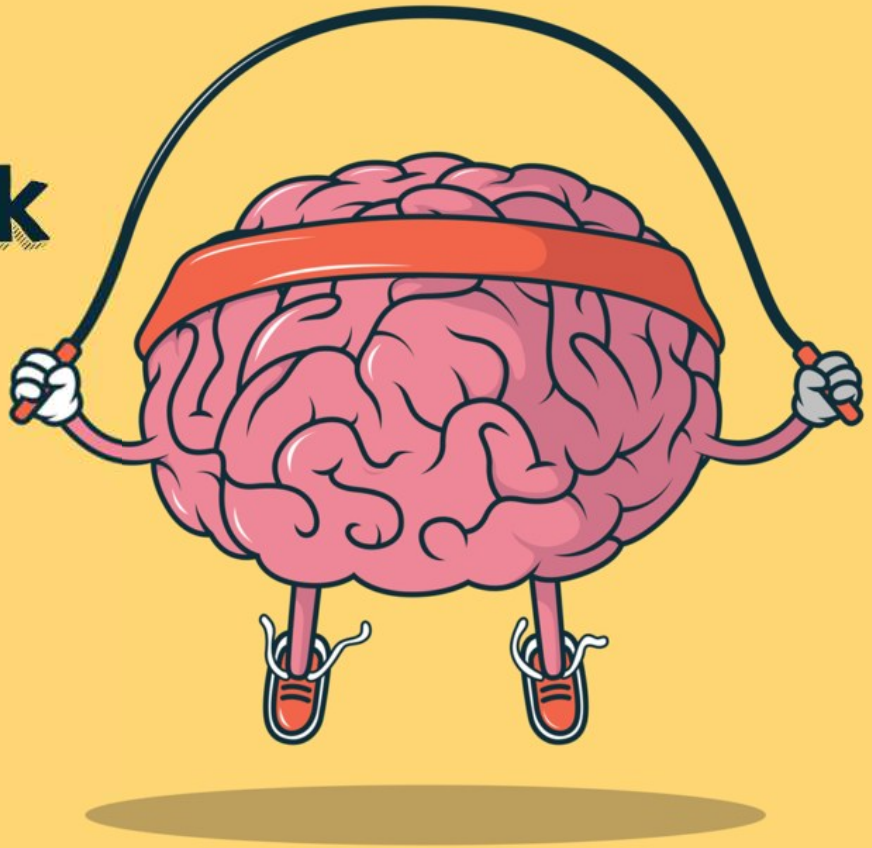

Maths

The Squirrels' class will be learning to identify triangles in their environment. The children will be going on a shape hunt to find as many triangles that they can. We will also be looking at their different properties. At home, you can encourage your child to use masking tape, in the garden or on carpet, to create their own triangles. A great way to do this is by demonstrating first and then supporting your child to make theirs.

Literacy

This week, the Squirrels' class will be looking at symmetry in butterfly wings. The children will be creating their own symmetrical designs, whilst practising their tripod grip. At home, you could create a pattern using coloured blocks and ask your child to copy the pattern.

Project

This week, in our 'All About Me' project, the Squirrels' class will be continuing to learn about their 5 senses. We will be focusing on our sense of smell, and the children will be taking part in a blind smell test. You can try this at home too. Remember to encourage your child to use their nose to guess the smell.
