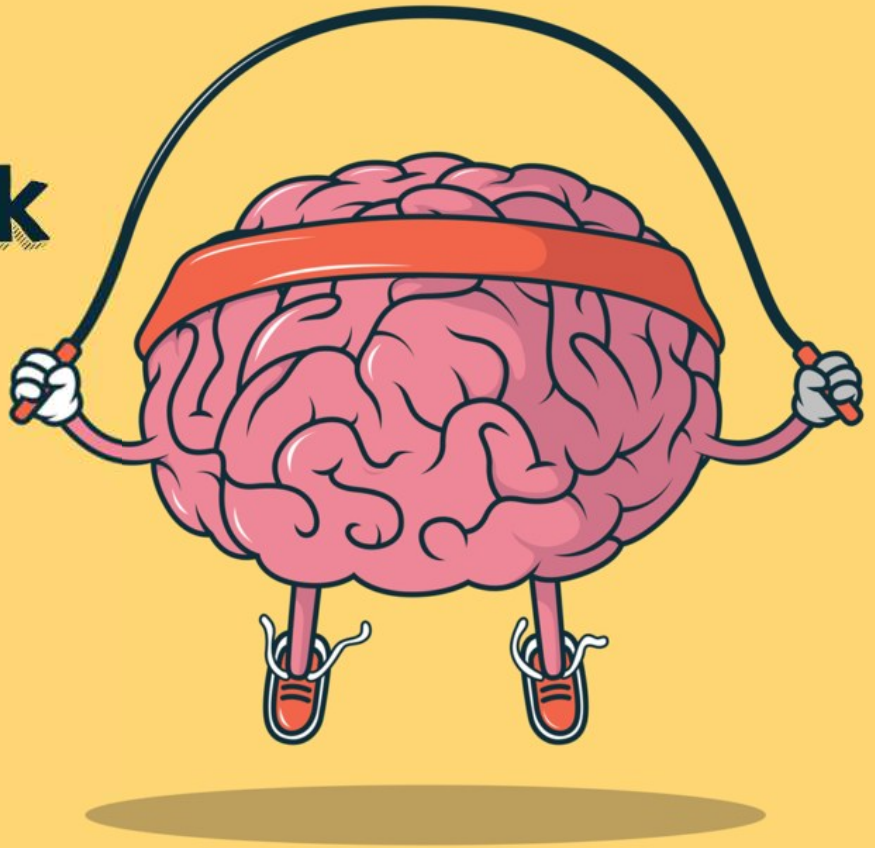

Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be learning to count objects to 2. At home, you can support your child to pair up objects that you can find around the house that add up to 2. For example, 2 spoons, 2 toy cars or 2 cushions.

Literacy

This week, the Squirrels' class will be creatively using tools to make marks in a cornflour mix. At home, you can use the end of a paintbrush, spoons or even your fingers to make marks in a small tray or small plate of flour. You could also encourage your child to make straight lines or circles.

Project

This week, the children will be drawing their own self-portraits. The children will be using mark making tools to create their drawings. Your children will be describing their features and their body parts using key vocabulary such as head, shoulders, knees, toes, ears, nose, eyes and mouth. At home, you can support the children by practising their tripod grip and encouraging them to point to their body parts. A great way to do this is through the song "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes".
