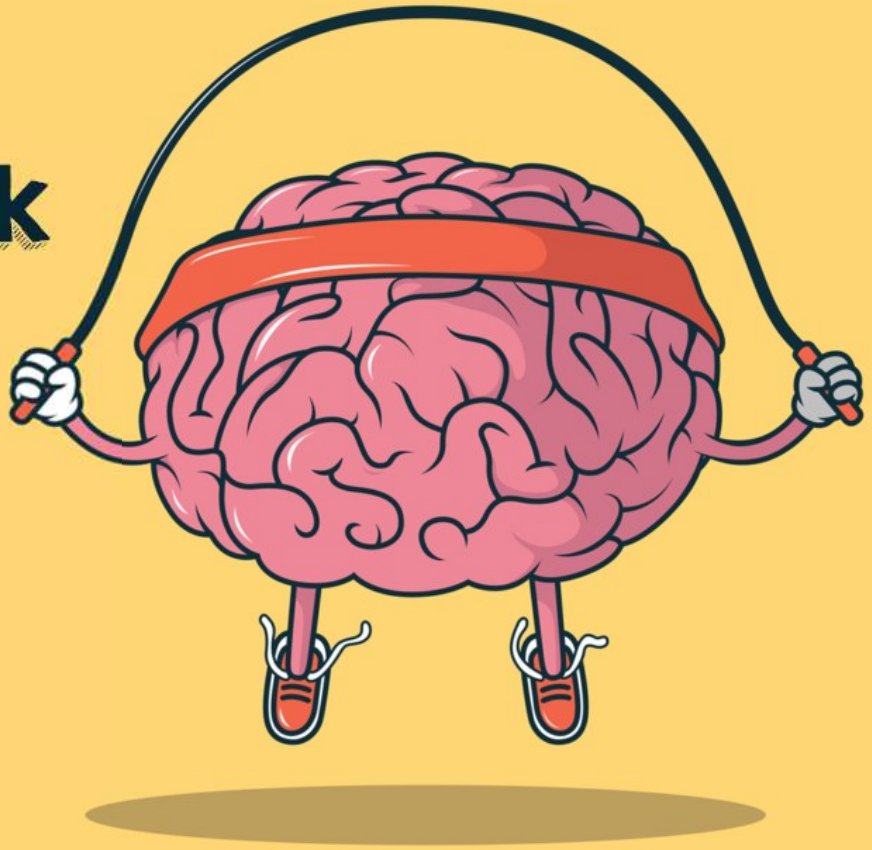

Maths

This week, the Hedgehogs' class will be learning about prepositions. They will be doing this with everyday objects. For example, "Can you put your water on top of the yellow tray?" The children will be practising 'on top', 'next to', 'in front' and 'behind'. At home, you could use a teddy and ask your child to place the teddy in and around different parts of a sofa or chair.

Literacy

This week, the children will be doing activities to support the development of their fine motor skills. The children will be using their gross motor skills to create both clockwise and anti-clockwise circular marks on the ground, fence and large paper. At home, you could provide the children with chalk to create clockwise and anti-clockwise circles outside. They could then use a paintbrush and water to erase their markings.

Understanding the world

This week, the class will be looking at the different colour fireworks make. We will also be listening to the different crackles and bangs they make. At home, you could discuss the importance of keeping safe and staying far away from fireworks. You could also look at the loud noise they make and see if you can spot some during the week or weekend.
