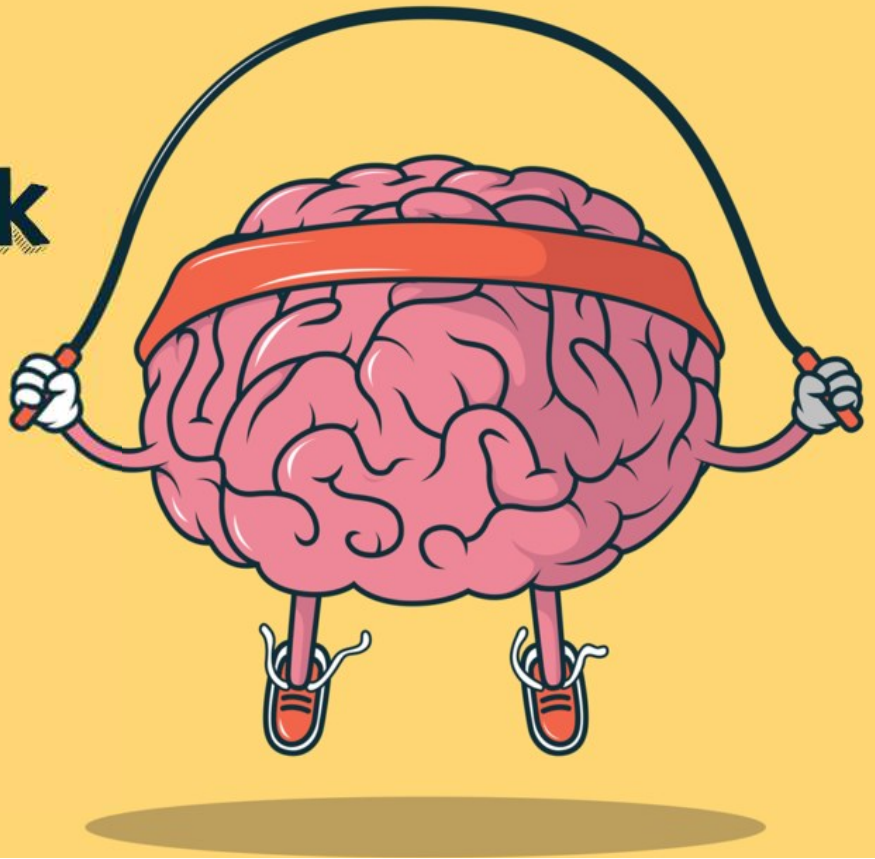

### Literacy

In our Writing lessons this week, the children will use subordinating conjunctions in their writing. A subordinating conjunction is a word or phrase that links a dependent clause to an independent clause. This word or phrase indicates that a clause has informative value to add to the sentence's main idea, signalling a cause-and-effect relationship or a shift in time and place between the two clauses. At home, encourage your child to use subordinating conjunctions in their own writing.

### Maths

In Maths lessons this week, the children will be studying how to balance equations. We will examine the rule of balancing equations understanding that the rule is that both sides of the equation must equal the same. We will understand the importance of showing our workings out and checking our work using the inverse. At home, encourage your child to practise balancing equations through walking talking maths opportunities.

### Science

In Science this week, the children will continue their investigations into Light. They will conduct a hands-on experiment to observe static electricity, discovering how rubbing certain materials can cause objects to attract or repel each other. These activities will help them understand how electric charges move, laying the foundation for how flowing electricity can power a light bulb. At home, why not enjoy a visit to the Science Museum? Focus particularly on the exhibits about electricity and light. Encourage your child to explain how energy is transformed into light.
