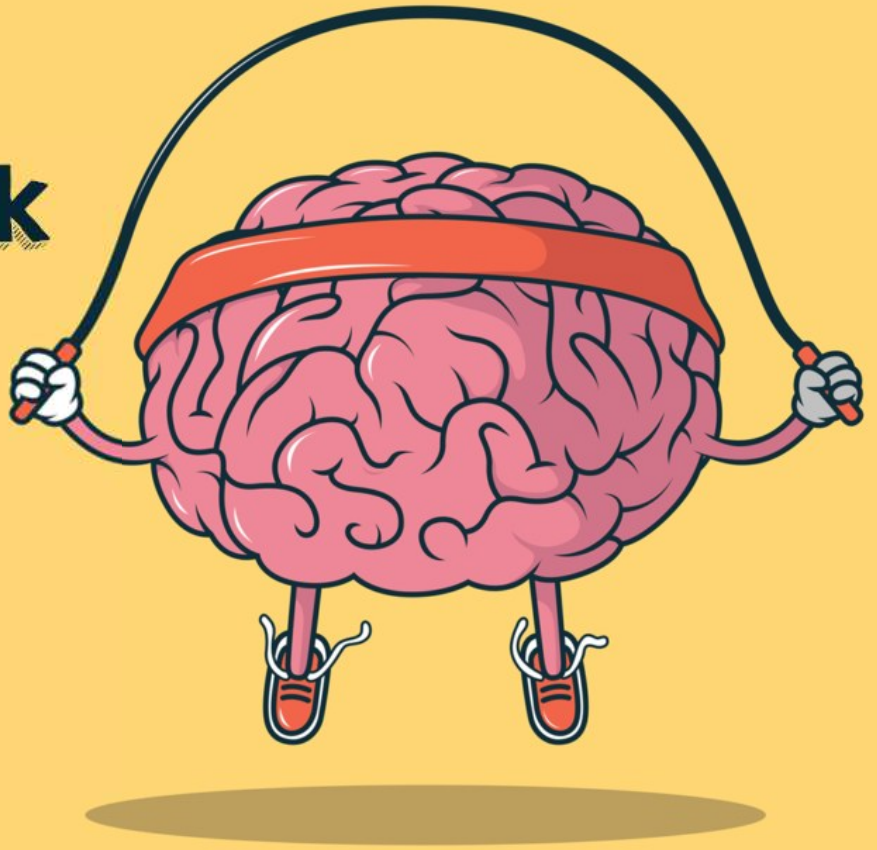

Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be recognising the number 2. At home, you could ask the children to find this number in different rooms. You could also go for a walk and see how many of this number you can see. Your child can also use some chalk to make their own representation of the number.

Literacy

In the Squirrels' class this week, the children will be drawing self-portraits using mark-making tools. The children will be describing their features using key vocabulary such as: head, ears, nose, eyes and mouth. At home, you can support your child with practising their tripod grip. You can also encourage your child to point to different parts of their body, through the rhyme 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes'.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This week, we will be looking at our daily routines. The children will be learning all about their daily routines and how to be more independent. We will explore role play scenarios where we take care of ourselves with hair brushes, tooth brushes and using zippers. This will help encourage their fine motor skills as well as build confidence. At home, try encouraging your child to take their own shoes off.
