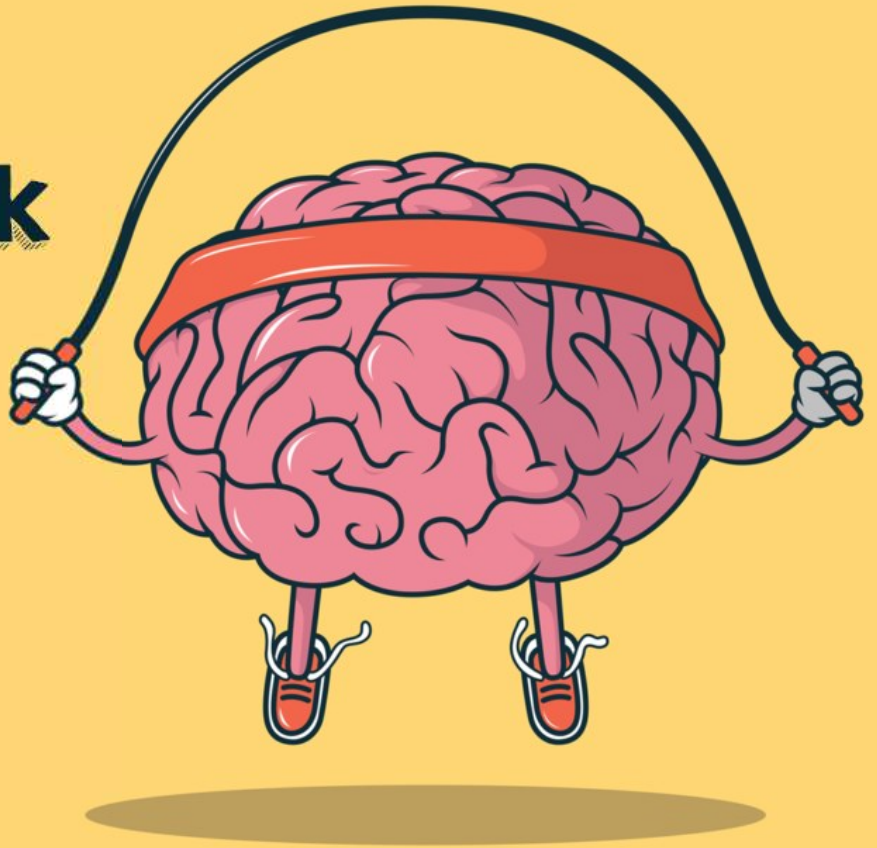

### Literacy

In our writing lessons this week, children will reflect on their weekend and use contractions in their writing. We will continue to use commas to show lists as well as coordinating conjunctions such as for, yet, but, or and so. When using a contraction, we omit one or more letters and replace them with an apostrophe. For example: "We would've been there earlier, but we missed the early train." At home, we encourage you to check that contracted words have an apostrophe in the appropriate place.

### Maths

In Maths this week, the children will be unpicking worded problems by using the RUCSAC method. The children will underline important words that give them leads to the correct operation. We will face some challenging problems and use our knowledge of different units of measure to make conversions and work out ratios. At home encourage your child to review some word problems practised in lessons.

### Science

This week in Science, the children will learn about sustainability by exploring renewable and non renewable resources and how everyday choices impact the planet. At home, they can take part in a "Mini Sustainability Challenge" by saving energy, sorting recycling, or finding eco friendly swaps with their families.
