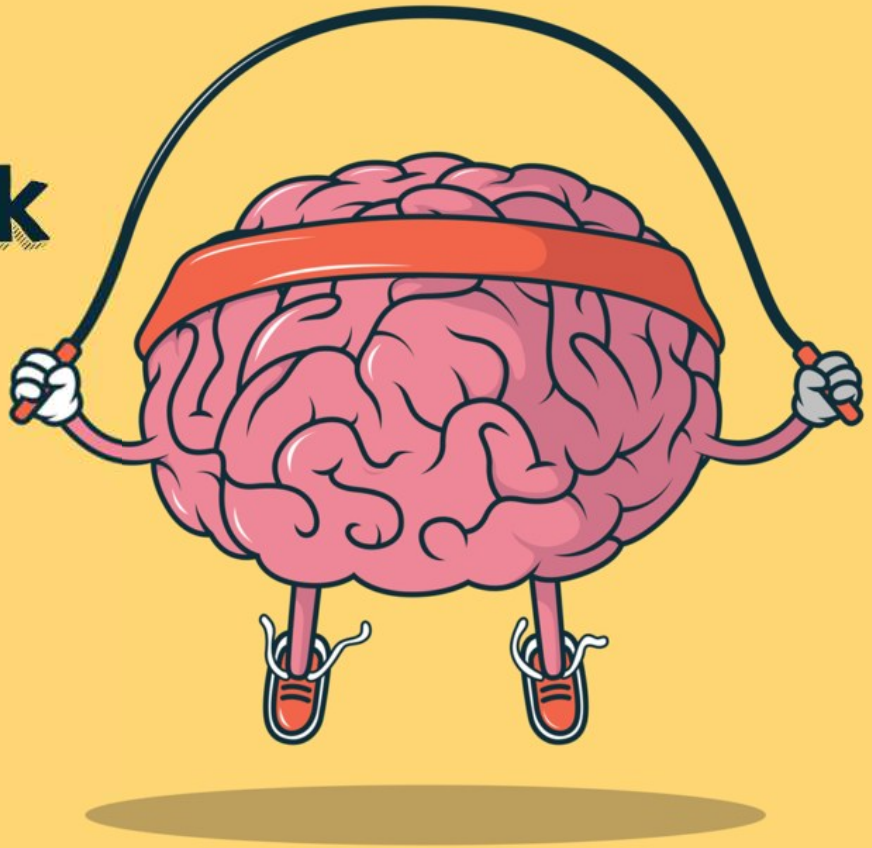

Maths

This week, the Squirrels' class will be learning about preposition. The children will be practising 'on top', 'next to', 'in front' and 'behind'. At home, you could use a teddy and ask the children to place the teddy in and around different parts of a sofa or chair.

Literacy

This week, the Squirrels' class will be creatively using tools to make marks in a cornflour mix. At home, you can use the end of a paintbrush, spoons and fingers to make marks in a small tray or a small plate of flour. You could also encourage the children to make straight lines or circles. Remember to support the children by encouraging them to hold the writing material with their thumb and first two fingers. This is known as the 'Tripod grip'.

Project

This week, in our 'People Who Help Us' project, the children will be exploring what a doctor does and some of the equipment that they use to help us. This topic will begin with discussions and activities about what a doctor does and if we have any past experiences. At home, ask the children why they think we go to the doctors and maybe create your own clinic to help the bears that felt unwell.
